- Ensure Preventative Maintenance (PM) plans, procedures and schedules in place and followed.
- Ensure accurate and timely reporting of and planning for facility downtime.
- Perform Day-to-Day maintenance related activities, includes repair, maintenance, services on rotating and stationary surface equipment
- Trouble shoot and find resolution to problems
- Utilize the Record Keeping system and ensure proper documentation
- Engage third party contactors (when required) and organize and manage their day to day duties
- Assist operators in field related tasks as required or directed by the Lead Operator, Foreman or Superintendent
- Identify optimization techniques to increase production and/or reduce downtime
- Ensure accurate and timely capture of field costs and participate in operating cost reduction initiatives.
- Assist with inventory management for area, ensuring adequate local availability of critical part inventory, source equipment for performing maintenance tasks in accordance with procurement procedures.
- Support all regulatory compliance programs as required
