- Valid Class 5 Operator's Licence, or equivalent.

- Minimum 3 years operations experience with a good understanding of process equipment used in SAGD operations such as: water-tube boilers, glycol heaters and systems, instrument/utility air systems, high pH mechanical vapour compressor evaporators, crystallizers, FWKOs, Treaters, diluent recovery, tank vapour compression, produced water de-oiling.
- SAGD or other commissioning and start-up experience is an asset.
- Ability to read and interpret facility drawings.
- Self-motivated with a strong work ethic, good communication skills, and a positive attitude.
- Proficient with personal computers, software applications, and facility control systems.
