To achieve the above objectives, Harvest sets the following guiding principles:

- Clearly define roles and responsibilities and support efficient communication throughout the organization
- Assess, Identify, assess and control workplace and task hazards
- Report and investigate all incidents
- Comply with provincial and federal acts, legislation and regulations
- Establish a safe and healthy working environment for all employees, contractors, sub-contractors and visitors
- Protect & maintain the health and safety (including physical, psychological, and social well-being) of employees
- Prevent or minimize pollution/ damage to the natural environment
- Ensure management, supervisors and workers understand applicable workplace health and safety rights and responsibilities (right to know, right to participate and right to refuse dangerous work)
